Small Group Guidelines

Maintain Confidentiality – Don't talk about things you hear in the group to people outside the group. This will help develop an atmosphere of trust. (NOTE: There is no way that the group can guarantee confidentiality, so use discretion about what you share.)

Sharing – There is no requirement that you talk in the group, but you are encouraged to do so! If you do share please comment only on your situation.

Be Sensitive – Some of you are naturally outgoing and comfortable in sharing your feelings. Some of you are a bit more shy. If you are outgoing, make sure you do not dominate the group. If you tend to be quiet and shy, make an effort to participate (you will be glad you did).

Test Your Expectations – This is a group designed to help you and the other group members navigate the grieving process. It is not an environment to encourage dating relationships (as you'll see on the video tapes, dating too early can add to your hurt!)
